About ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation

The ORLEN Unipetrol launched its activities in 2017. During its existence, it has distributed CZK 9 million within the scholarship program to 323 secondary school and university students of natural sciences and technical disciplines. As part of the school grant program, the Foundation distributed CZK 12.6 million to 94 secondary and primary schools throughout the country to support their education and science activities. It supported 45 teachers with CZK 1.6 million as part of the grant program for teachers.

The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation's activities are based on three main pillars of support.

We create the future now. Chemical disciplines are the most significantly changing segment. That is why we support talented students, schools, and scientists in their activities and development.

I. Grants and Scholarships

The scholarship program is intended for secondary school and university students with excellent study results and talents in natural sciences with an emphasis on chemistry and technology. The study results are the main, yet not the only, criterion for getting financial support. The way the students spend their free time, their active engagement in society and their involvement in scientific activities are equally important.

The grant program is designed for kindergartens, primary and secondary schools to develop educational activities and implement attractive scientific projects. Thus, the grant can be used to purchase technical equipment or implement projects led by students within school clubs and workshops.

The grant program for teachers acknowledges the above-standard approach of teachers of natural sciences who motivate

their students to their continuous interest in the curriculum and studies and are actively engaged in self-development to make lessons more attractive.

II. Scientific and Educational Projects, Science Popularization

As part of the Foundation's support of education and related activities, many educational materials and instructive videos (tutorials) were created. They are now available at www.nounonline.cz. Thus, students and teachers can find all documents well-arranged and divided into themes in one place.

III. Charity Activities

Although our primary objective is to support education, we are also happy to help those needing our assistance. The Foundation cooperates with many non-profit organizations, also in reaction to the current societal events and emergencies.

Scholarship Grant Program

The scholarship program is intended for talented students of natural sciences with an emphasis on chemistry and technology.

In the school year 2022/2023, the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation provided students at secondary schools and universities with scholarships totaling CZK 815,000 to support their education.

Forty-four students were successful in the scholarship program. The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation supported four smart students of the youth team of HC VERVA Litvínov with CZK 80,000.

The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation also supported 17 students from socially disadvantaged families with CZK 255,000 through the Endowment Fund of Livie Klausová and Václav Klaus. This year, we have started cooperating with Kateřina Sokolová's endowment fund, AuřTalk, which supports the education of children with autism. We supported the endowment fund with CZK 150,000.

The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation supported students with CZK 1.3 million within the 6th scholarship grant program.

Grant Program for Schools


The grant program supports schools and education for the fifth year. The grants are allocated to equip chemical laboratories, science clubs or school projects related to natural sciences. In the school year 2022/2023, 29 schools or institutions, including 16 secondary schools and 11 primary schools, the Ústí Region, and the Centre for Mothers, were eligible for getting the grant. Altogether, they received CZK 2,300,000 from the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation.

Grant Program for Teachers

The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation also appreciates the above-standard approach of educators specialized in natural sciences. Through grants for teachers, it helps deepen teachers' activities for four years, thus allowing them to create new projects or clubs for children and encourage teachers to self-education in their fields. In 2022, the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation rewarded 18 teachers within the grant program for teachers. The distributed amount totaled CZK 400,000.

Horizon Hydrogen GRAND PRIX

The Horizon Hydrogen GRAND PRIX instruction program is based on project lessons. It provides students with insights and relevant scientific, technological, and engineering knowledge. The aim of all competitors' efforts over several months was to build an electric car model powered by a hydrogen fuel cell. The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation supported seven student teams in 2022, including five teams in the Czech Republic and newly two teams in Slovakia.

Hydrogen Workshop in Primary Schools



In collaboration with Václav Bystrianský from Hydrogen Educational, the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation organized hydrogen workshops for primary schools where they introduced the fuels of the 21st century to pupils at selected primary schools. Earlier, these schools were recommended to use educational sets to put together their own small hydrogen car, and this meeting was therefore with pupils interested in the hydrogen project. The lecture focused on the actual principle of the hydrogen motor, its production, and its pitfalls. Together we put a hydrogen cell into operation while pupils were also shown the basics of 3D design and 3D printing.

EDUbus

EDUbus is a unique mobile polytechnic laboratory where schoolchildren can try out a variety of chemical experiments in a funny way and take a peek at the modern teaching of chemistry. It is a unique educational project popularizing polytechnical disciplines using special teaching methods, state-of-the-art technologies, and an attractive environment. The project aims to motivate students, parents, and the lay public to dive deep into technical and natural sciences. It also includes an expert program for teachers accredited by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic.

The Foundation has been a partner of the project since its inception and was at its launch, which took place in April 2018 in front of Chempark in Litvínov. Five primary schools visited EDUbus in the Plzeň Region in 2022. Then, the mobile laboratory spent three days in Český Těšín and two days in Karviná. Eighteen Czech schools with Polish as the language of instruction enjoyed the roadshow.

Summer Workshop for Kindergartens and Primary Schools

The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation organized summer workshops led by professional lecturers for kindergarten and primary school teachers in the Training Centre in Litvínov. The event followed last year's 4EDU conference, which we organized to describe innovative forms of education and present examples of extracurricular activities and practice in the private sector. Therefore, the Foundation organized workshops for teachers led by professional lecturers with demonstrations of interesting forms of instruction. The workshops were divided into two groups. In the first one, the lecturers focused on teaching in kindergartens and lower primary schools, while the second group focused on forms of education in upper primary schools. Passing inspirational thoughts and ideas in realizing innovative chemistry instruction is vital for pupils to have a positive relationship with chemistry and focus on it professionally.

Student Scientific Conference

University of Chemistry and Technology in Prague (VŠCHT), ORLEN Unipetrol Centre of Research and Education (ORLEN UniCRE), the ORLEN Unipetrol Group and the Foundation rewarded the best secondary school students for their research projects. An expert jury of the seventh annual Student Scientific Conference selected works for the finals out of 32 entries. The finals took place on the premises of the University Centre of UCT - FE CTU - ORLEN Unipetrol located in the chemical plant in Záluží in March 2022. A jury comprising scientists and teachers from the organizing institutions chose from many exciting and high-quality works focused on, for example, biofuels or hydrogen-powered cars. The current themes, such as disinfectants and their antibacterial effects or analysis of alcohol-based disinfectants' composition or using 3D printing, strongly resonated among the selected topics. A total of CZK 141,000 was distributed among the 22 awarded students.



Fridays with Science



Fridays with Science is a project organized by the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation in collaboration with the Upper-secondary School of Josef Jungmann in Litoměřice. It aims to boost student interest in science and research through regular lectures by outstanding scientists and researchers. Several significant science and research personalities have already given presentations through Fridays with Sciences. All lectures are recorded and are available at www.nouonline.cz, both to students and the general public. Nine lectures were held in 2022.

Flying teacher and VIVIDBOOKS

In the school year 2021/2022, the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation launched a Flying Teacher project. With this project, it helps selected schools with chemistry lessons.

For the 2021/2022 academic year, a team of three expert chemistry teachers regularly visited primary schools in the Ústí Region. After an agreement with the teacher at a given school, they plan and realize interesting experiments several times a month that serve as an addition to the theoretical instruction of chemistry (in connection with the school's curriculum) and that pedagogues without expert competence could hardly perform on their own.

Regarding the experience so far, we have decided to expand this project in collaboration with VividBooks. These digital textbooks offer teachers everything necessary for the modern and meaningful instruction of scientific subjects in primary school. Seven primary schools which received a license for modern chemistry instruction are already involved in the project.

PC Bazaar

The PC Bazaar project aims to use discarded, remanufactured and yet completely functional computers owned by Unipetrol RPA in a meaningful way and donate them to schools for full-fledged utilization. Thus, the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation seeks to support the technical equipment at schools and institutions in the region. In 2022, the Foundation donated 30 computers and displays to schools and organizations working with disabled people, children, students, severely ill people, and their relatives.

Elixir for Schools

The Foundation is a partner of the chemical center of the Elixir for Schools project (Elixír do škol). Through teachers and regional centers, the center supports the development of education in technical fields and natural sciences in Czechia. The centers provide the space for meetings of teachers in the regions and share their experience under the leadership of an experienced colleague.

Plastík a jeho kouzelný kufřík



Plastík a jeho kouzelný kufřík (Plastík and his magic suitcase) is an educational program licensed by Plastic of Europe Deutschland. It is the first and only project in the Czech Republic provided by the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation to selected schools. This educational program is accredited by the Ministry of Education as part of teachers' further training. It is intended for lower primary school pupils (6-12 years). It allows teachers and their students to perform simple experiments using plastics. The project is provided to selected primary schools that can use it in the school's lower-level educational plans. The Foundation has provided the suitcase to more than 100 schools.



Uniriders Graceful Ride

The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation organized the fourth Graceful Ride under the patronage of the town of Kralupy nad Vltavou. Thus, members of the Uniriders motorbike club could contribute to charity projects with their hobby and help those who need it. The ride was attended by 70 bikers. The event was accompanied by a rich side program.

"The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation has organized the motor bikers' graceful ride for the fourth year. During this time, we collected over CZK 420,000 and divided the funds among five ill children and the Foundation of Police Officers and Firefighters," Katarzyna Woś explains.

This time, the total collected sum of CZK 100,000 went to support eight-year-old Štěpánka, suffering from severe epilepsy.

Cooperation with the ORLEN Unipetrol Sports Club

As part of the ORLEN Unipetrol Group's Sports Club, employees help through physical activity, and together they can fulfil other people's dreams. The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation converted sports activities and achievements into financial means that were handed over to specific persons or organizations. In 2022, our employees managed to raise CZK 220,000 for charity purposes through their physical activity. The employees themselves also choose which charities and people receive financial support. For instance, assistance went to the patients' organization Parent Project, founded by parents whose children were born with a rare, early-onset neuromuscular disease, and to the organization K srdci klíč (A Key to the Heart), which provides help to young adults leaving institutional care, such as children's homes, and lack the skills needed for independent life, such as looking for a job, finding housing, etc.

Aid for Ukraine Affected by War

As part of its charity activities, the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation always strives to respond quickly to current happenings in society and extraordinary events. We started collaborating with the Embassy of Ukraine in the Czech Republic and with the humanitarian organization ADRA, which is present directly in Ukraine. The Foundation also connected directly with municipalities for its help. A financial and material collection among the ORLEN Unipetrol Group's employees was organized. In collaboration with ORLEN Benzina, Stop Cafe products were sent directly to the Slovak-Ukrainian border.

Aid for Firefighters Who Tackled the Bohemian Switzerland Fire

The Foundation aided firefighters who tackled the destructive fire in the Bohemian Switzerland National Park for three weeks with a huge consignment of refreshments consisting of Stop Cafe store-brand products and Simply Fresh packaged baguettes from the offer of ORLEN Benzina filling stations. The firefighters received 1,000 Verva drinks, 800 Stop Cafe iced coffee beverages and 1,000 assorted baguettes and sandwiches.

Children's Home in Hora Sv. Kateřiny

In 2022 the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation, in collaboration with HC VERVA Litvínov's Konto našeho srdce (Our Heart's Account), supported children from the children's home in Hora Svate Kateřiny. At the end of August, with HC VERVA ice-hockey players Michal Gut and Marek Berka, they visited the children in Staré Splavy where they enjoyed their traditional one-week health and sports stay. The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation and Our Heart's Account contributed the amount of CZK 54,000 each to this stay.

School through Play or Merkur Helps

Within supporting education, the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation and Konto našeho srdce (Our Heart's Account) handed over 100 Merkur construction sets worth CZK 110,000 to the Private Sports Primary School in Litvínov.

The ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation contributed one-half of the amount, and the other half was added by HC VERVA Litvínov's Our Heart's Account. Together they supported the "School through Play or Merkur Helps" project.

Educational Merkur construction sets help lower primary school pupils in almost all subjects.

Vize 97's St. Nicholas Bazaar

During Advent, the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation participated in the St. Nicholas Bazaar event organized by the VIZE 97 Dagmar and Václav Havel Foundation. Together with other non-profit organizations and organizations helping people in need, the ORLEN Unipetrol Foundation created a pleasant pre-Christmas atmosphere on the beautiful premises of St. Anne's Church. While carols were sung or after reciting a poem to St. Nicholas, children could stop by the Foundation's stand, where a Christmas coloring book was prepared for them. In addition to colored pencils and markers, phosphorescent paints were prepared for them, and thanks to a UV lamp, they glowed beautifully in their pictures. They left the stand with a glowing picture of a Christmas tree or an angel that would glow even at night.

The purpose of the Foundation is philanthropic and charitable. 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II. General Accounting Principles

II.1. Accruals and Deferrals

The organization records deferred expenses. Deferred expenses are used for the accrual of expenses related to the following accounting periods. The organization does not accrue expenses that are repeated each year and expenses of negligible value, i.e., up to CZK 2,000.

II.2. Received Donations

The organization records received donations through funds and directly credits and debits them to account 211 – Cashier or 221 – Bank Account. The organization continuously records the distribution of donations in the form of foundation contributions by double entry to the Foundation’s debts and in favor of accounts 221 – Bank Account or 211 – Cashier, or in the form of use of donations for activity by a double entry to the Foundation’s debts and in favor of account 648 – drawing of the fund. The reported balance of the individual donation fund corresponds to the amount of unused donations.

II.3. Public Collection

In funds on account 911 – Public Collection Fund, the organization accounts for resources obtained from the public collection. The organization continuously accounts for the use of the proceeds of the public collection for foundation contributions to the Foundation’s debts and in favor of accounts 221 – Bank Account or 211 – Petty Cash, or in the form of use of donations for activity by a double entry to the Foundation’s debts and in favor of account 648 – Accounting for the fund. The reported balance of the public collection fund corresponds to the unspent amount from the public collection intended for further use, i.e., the balance of the collection bank account as of the balance sheet date.

II.4. Received Subsidies

Received subsidies are funds provided from public sources, i.e., mainly from the state budget, from the budgets of regional self-governing units, from state budgets of foreign states, etc. The organization accounts for these funds upon acceptance in the commitment accounts of group 34, or directly in revenues on account 691 – Subsidies. If the entire received amount of the subsidy is not spent by the end of the year, the remaining amount is reported as a liability in the account of group 34 – Liabilities against the state budget. In the event that more is spent within the subsidized project than has been received under the subsidy so far, the organization charges an estimated item to the debit of account 388 – Estimated items in favor of account 691 – Subsidies, so that the profit from the subsidy is always zero.

II.5. Equity

The organization’s equity consists of the contribution of the founder, ORLEN UNIPETROL RPA, s.r.o., in the amount of CZK 500,000.

The Foundation’s equity is a monetary expression of the Foundation’s principal, which consists of the founder’s contribution described above. The equity includes funds and profit. The equity includes funds and profit/loss.

II.6. Income Tax

The organization exempts the received donations under Section 19b of the Income Tax Act wherever possible.

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III. Additional Information to the Financial Statements

III.1. Assets and Liabilities

The organization does not record any long-term or small assets. The organization does not record any long-term liabilities with a maturity of more than five years from the balance sheet date. It also does not record any assets or liabilities not stated in the balance sheet.

III.2. Employees and Personnel Expenses

In 2022, the organization had no permanent employees; it had only temporary employees working under the agreement to perform a job scheme. Total wages and salaries amounted to CZK 140,000; other personnel expenses were zero.

In 2022, the members of the governing bodies did not receive any remuneration and fringe benefits, nor did they receive any loans, credits, guarantees or other performance. The members of the governing bodies do not have any property interest in the persons with whom the organization entered into contractual relations in 2022.
